Statement on Allowable Use of Funds

As part of our 2025-27 Jail-based Medications for Opioid Use Disorder (JMOUD) Grant Program application, the County of Tillamook acknowledges that any grant funds received under this program must be expended in accordance with the allowable uses as described in Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 213-100-0040, subsection (3)(d). Consistent with our JMOUD project narrative and budget, the allowable use of funding categories that are applicable to our proposed scope of work include:

- Providing medication, telemedicine, or any other reasonable treatment to persons in custody with an opioid disorder;
- Facilitating transition planning services for persons in custody who seek or receive opioid use disorder treatment.
